

# **Biographical Note**

Albert W. Bussewitz (1912-1995) was born in Juneau, Wisconsin and attended Northwestern University. He was a former director of a few Massachusetts Audubon sites including Moose Hill in Sharon, Stony Brook in Norfolk, and Rocky Knoll in Milton and was also president of the Thoreau Society (1970-1971). In 1980, he was awarded Master Member of the New England Camera Club Council and received the Richard D. Perkins Memorial Award from the Henry David Thoreau School of Wilderness Studies. He was honored by the Arboretum as Volunteer of the Year in 1993.

In 1978, after his retirement from Massachusetts Audubon, he and his wife Flora moved to Jamaica Plain and both began a long association with the Arnold Arboretum. Known to all as "Buzzy" he was an extremely active Arboretum docent between 1981-1995 leading tours, delivering lectures, photographing birds and the landscape, and creating exhibits. The collection contains a small selection of some of his photographic work, photographs of Bussewitz in the field leading tours, and images of his 80th birthday party and his memorial service; both were held at the Arboretum.
